

After 6 years at sea, he worked at Quaglinos, The Cafe de Paris, and Showboat in London. His Jazz career includes recording with American greats Bud Freeman and Wild Bill Davison.

Mike Daly has been playing professionally since he was 17 and has become one of the most tasteful and exciting cornet players on the UK jazz scene. His style has been influenced by players such as Bobby Hackett and Ruby Braff and one visiting American jazz critic, after hearing him at the Edinburgh Jazz Festival, claimed he was the closest thing to Bix Beiderbecke!




